EHF IMPACT

Nikald's Story: From Homelessness to Peace of Mind

2025 was an especially challenging year for **Nikald**, marked by periods of homelessness, food insecurity, and financial instability. As a substitute teacher, she faced inconsistent income during the summer months and struggled to cover basic necessities. While her income stabilized once school resumed, the accumulated bills remained overwhelming.

Through HIF's partner, LifeMoves, Nikald received an **Emergency Housing Fund (EHF)** grant that allowed her to catch up on overdue bills, address critical expenses, and meet her daily needs—helping her regain stability and move forward.



This grant has been a tremendous help in alleviating my mental stress and giving me peace of mind. It supported me through multiple hardships, including food and utility bills, and allowed me to focus on getting back on track financially with a much clearer mindset. After experiencing homelessness in the past, I was deeply afraid of facing that situation again. This support provided the stability and security I needed.”

Bill Wilson Update: We are grateful to **Equity, BKB, ProFloors, Urban Renovation and Construction West Inc., and VCS** for their generous support of the Bill Wilson Center project. Their partnership continues to move this important work forward.

Scope of work includes: A redesigned kitchen to better support nutrition and life-skills education, featuring new cabinets, appliances, and expanded counter space; new flooring throughout the unit; fresh paint and updated fixtures; a bathroom renovation to assess and repair prior water damage; a new roof; and light landscaping improvements.
