Jamie's Story: A Fresh Start

After being homeless for over two years and facing depression, PTSD, and two hip replacement surgeries, **Jamie** was physically, emotionally, and spiritually exhausted. Securing a new home felt impossible until HIF stepped in with the support he needed.

Throughout this time, Jamie's two year old pit bull was his constant companion and emotional anchor. While moving into a new home brought relief and hope, it also brought new challenges for his dog, and Jamie is just beginning to get back on his feet, navigating medical coverage, SSI, and rebuilding his life.

Jamie's journey has been marked by profound loss, including the death of his partner and struggles with addiction, yet he continues to heal and move forward. He says, "I am deeply grateful. Grateful for this roof, for your help, and for the chance to start again."

Thanks to supporters like you, people like Jamie can find stability, safety, and the opportunity to rebuild their lives.

A Mother's Strength: Finding Home Through HIF

Lisa is a single mother in San Jose, raising her 4-year-old daughter who lived with epilepsy. Since infancy, her daughter had faced seizures, sometimes at school, with relatives, and even in the car, making daily life a constant balancing act of vigilance and care.

Working three jobs to cover therapy, daycare, and medical needs, Lisa struggled to find safe, affordable housing that met her daughter's health requirements, like central air, heating, and in-unit laundry. Amenities such as a pool or playground would have given her daughter the chance to play, move, and build friendships.

Through our Affordable Housing Initiative (AHI), she found a home that meets her daughter's needs, one with safety, stability, and amenities like a pool, playground, or gym where her daughter can be active, engaged, and social with other children.

Despite her challenges, she continues her 13-year career working with children and adults with special needs, helping others even as she works tirelessly for her own daughter's future.

Because of supporters like you, families like Lisa's can create more stable and secure futures for their children.
